



# Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

The Emergency Broadband Benefit (“EBB”) is a government program that supports broadband services for families who qualify and is temporary in nature. It will only last as long as the funding is available.

*The Emergency Broadband Program is only available to customers in the Indiantown Service Area.*



---

**This program is funded by the US Treasury and is separate from the Lifeline Program.**

- The EBBP discount is for Internet service and specific Blue Stream Fiber supplied router/modem equipment charges.
- There is a \$50.00 credit for Internet services purchased from Blue Stream Fiber.
- There are specific Internet packages and Internet/Voice bundles that qualify for the credit.
- This credit does not apply to WiFi extender units, if purchased.
- If you are a Lifeline customer, you may also participate and will receive both credits.

(Must meet the qualifications in one of the programs listed below):

- SNAP (Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program; formerly Food Stamps)
  - Medicaid
  - SSI (Supplemental Security Income)
  - Veteran's and Survivors Pension Program
  - Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA) Veteran's and Survivors Pension Program
  - Free and reduced School Lunch or School Breakfast Program
  - Pell Grant

## How Do I Sign Up for EBBP?

- You must confirm that you have received disclosures information below from our customer service:
  - Confirm you understand that the program is a temporary government program.
  - At the end of the program the rates will no longer be discounted and will return to regular pricing and the regular terms and conditions.
  - You consent to the EBBP being added to your current service
- 

## EBBP Facts & Disclosures

- The EBBP is a government program that reduces your Internet bill
- The program is temporary for as long as funds last
- Once the program has ended all regular pricing and terms and conditions will go into effect, if you wish to continue with Internet service
- You may transfer EBBP benefit to another service provider at any time
